

## Alnmouth Village Golf Club – Dress Code

**ACCEPTABLE**

**Shirts**  
Shirts must be tucked in & have collars or mock collars and sleeves.

**Trousers / Shorts**  
Knee length tailored shorts or long trousers.

**Socks**  
Long, Ankle & Trainer socks.

**Shoes**  
Golf shoes.

**UNACCEPTABLE**

**Shirts**  
Untucked shirts, T-shirts, Vests, Rugby/Football Shirts, Blue Denim.

**Shorts**  
More than 4" above knee. Beach Shorts, Rugby/Football Shorts, Blue Denim.

**Socks**  
No socks.

**Shoes**  
Trainers or improper golf shoes.

**DRESS RULES**  
FOR COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES

**ACCEPTABLE**

**Shirts**  
Shirts must have collars. Shirts designed to be worn outside shorts are acceptable.

**Socks**  
Long, Ankle & Trainer socks.

**UNACCEPTABLE**

**Shirts**  
Cropped tops/ Strappy tops, T-shirts etc, Blue Denim.

**Shorts/Skirts**  
More than 4" above knee. Beach Shorts, Blue Denim.

**No Socks.**

**DRESS RULES**  
FOR COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES

### The Game, Player Conduct and the Rules - Rules of Golf Rule 1 refers.

In particular: -

- No practice swings/divots on tee areas.
- No practicing on the course
- Play without delay – slow players should allow others to play through rather than hold up the group behind.
- Keep noise to a minimum.
- On 2<sup>nd</sup> tee players must wait for the 7<sup>th</sup> Green to clear before teeing off
- Players playing from 6<sup>th</sup> tee have priority over players playing on 3<sup>rd</sup> green.
- Please remember to ring the bell on the 6<sup>th</sup> hole to signal the group behind that the fairway is clear.
- Tee off from 7<sup>th</sup> tee – players should wait until 3<sup>rd</sup> green is clear before teeing off.
- On the 8<sup>th</sup> tee please wait until the 2<sup>nd</sup> green is clear before teeing off.
- Please allow people and vehicles to cross the road that bisects the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Fairways.
